PARKING LOT SAFETY

Please be patient and plan accordingly for school arrival and pick-up. A few reminders to follow:

- Do not drop off, pick up or park in the bus lanes in front of the school doors.
- Please follow the traffic flow pattern in the school and church parking lots. When **dropping students off in the morning**, please drive along the far east part of the parking lot (closest to Crooked Lake Elementary), following the arrows. As you make the turn to drive along the front of the school, pull up as far as possible to drop your student off.
- If you are **picking up your student(s) at the end of the day**, we ask that you pick them up on the west side (church side) of the complex. Enter the "pick up line" that will drive through the church semi-circle. Please pull up as far as possible when the space opens up. If you have waited for a few minutes after the students have been dismissed, we ask that you move your car out of the line and park in the lot while you wait. If you are parked in the lot, we ask that you come to meet younger children as they will not be allowed to go through the parking lot to their car.
- Students should enter and exit cars safely, but as quickly as possible. If you need to assist your child(ren), please park in a parking space out of the flow of traffic. We ask that you be mindful of cars waiting behind you. (Traffic backed up on Bunker Lake Blvd. can be very hazardous!)
- There are faculty/staff supervisors assigned to oversee these safety procedures. Please show them respect and follow their instructions.
