IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM DISTRICT #11 TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

District #11 Transportation Policy prohibits students from riding on buses other than their own. The District #11 Student Transportation Policy states, "Students will not be allowed to ride a bus home from school for work, baby-sitting, piano lessons, scouts, or visiting friends. The only exception to this policy is in the event of an emergency. If the parent/guardian is away from home, arrangements must be made with the building principal. The

parent/guardian must designate (in writing) an adult who will supervise their child in their absence. In turn, the building principal will issue a pass for the student to ride the appropriate bus. It is important that this policy be followed to ensure the Transportation Department knows which children are on each of the buses in the event of an emergency. This policy also minimizes the possibility of students boarding the wrong bus and going to the wrong location."

TRANSPORTATION AND BUNKER LAKE BOULEVARD

Parents, please be aware that there is no crossing guard on Bunker Lake Boulevard at any time. The road should be recognized as a wide span, high and fast traffic road. Please talk to your student(s) about the dangers of this crossing.
