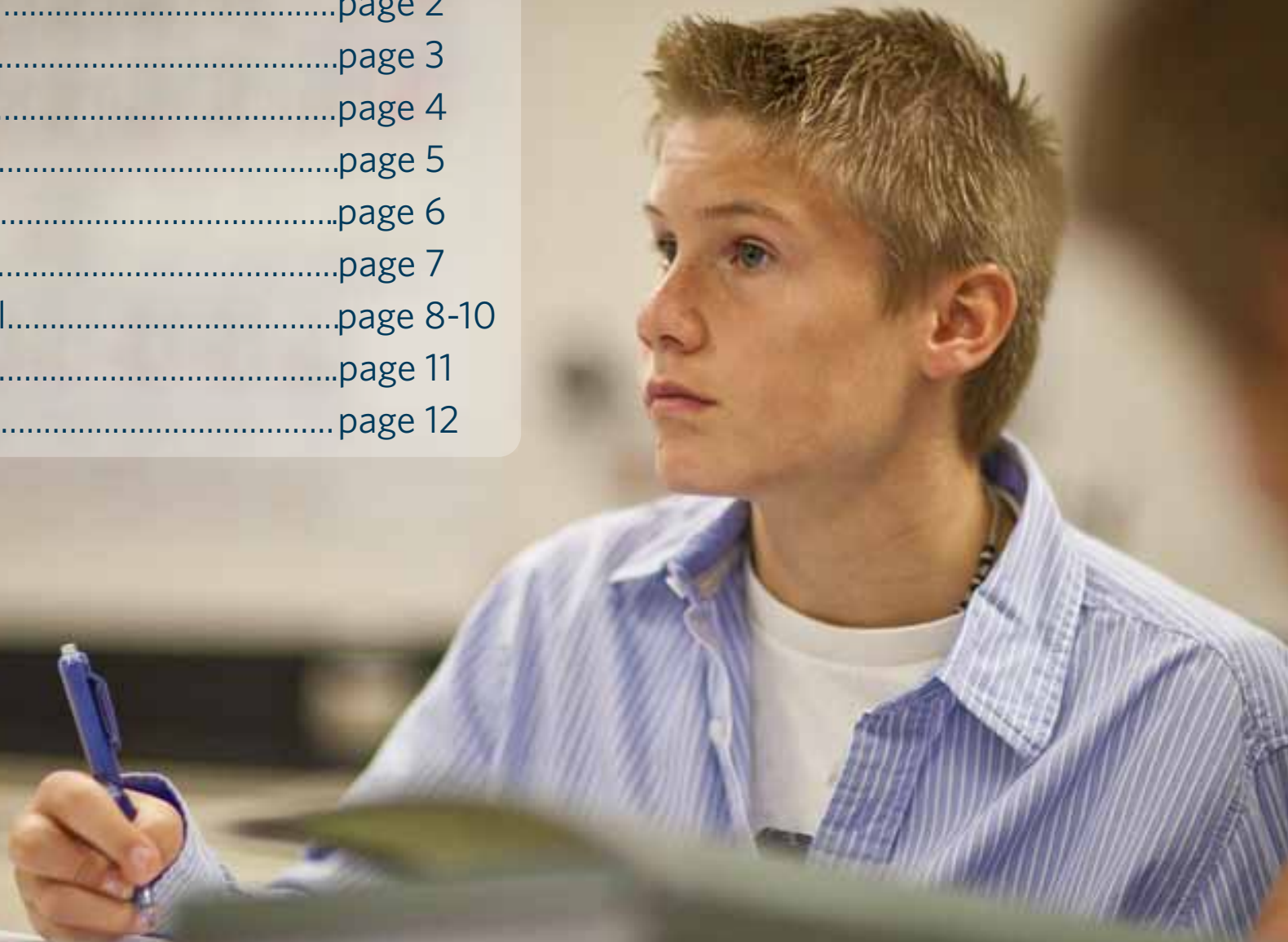

## THE OPPORTUNITY »

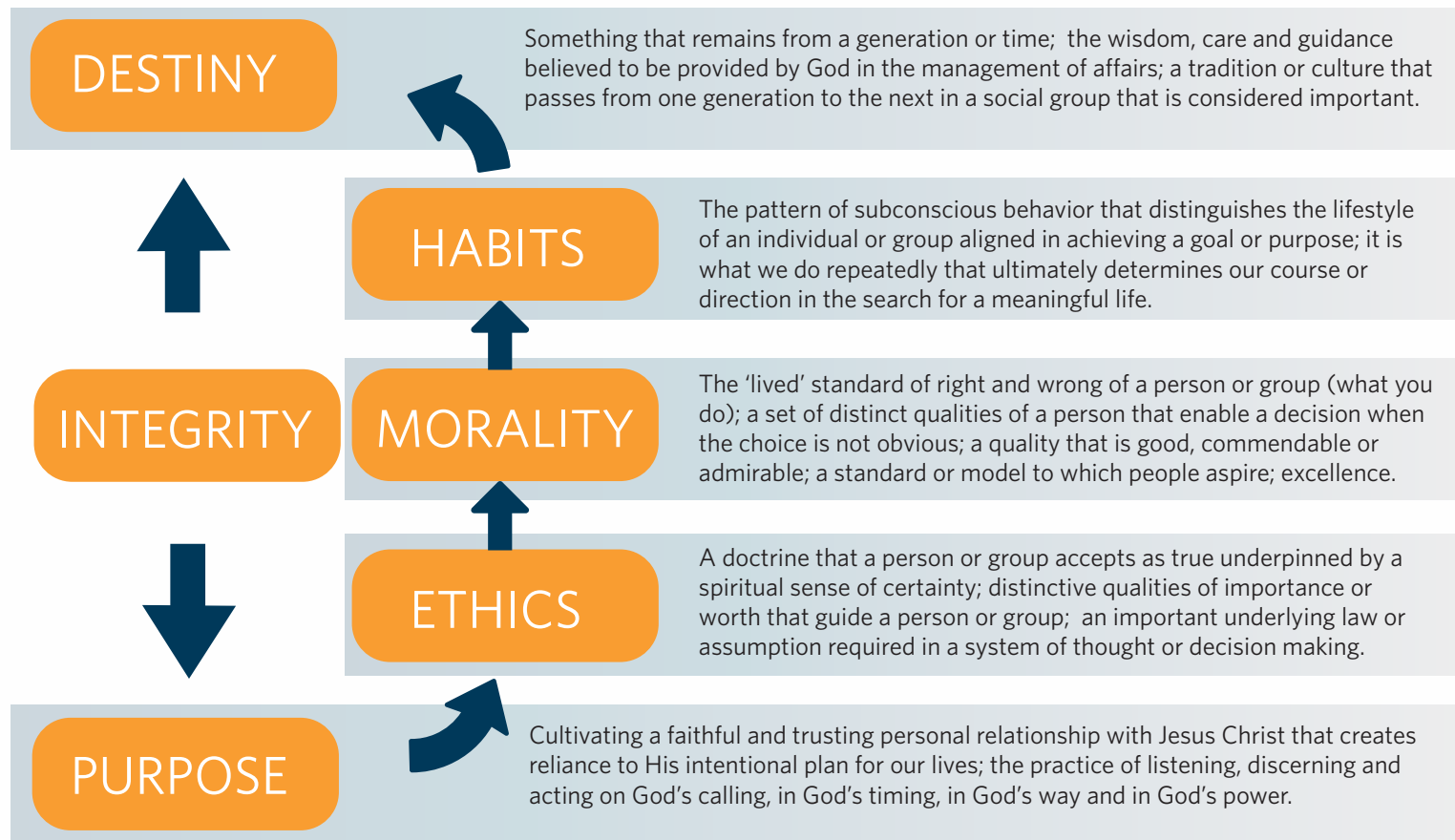
***As Christians, we are called to be a light to this dark world.***

## LCA PURPOSE »

**Vision »** *Cultivating Christian Leaders to change our world.*

**Create a Legacy Leader »** *A Legacy Leader is transformational in the way they and their followers raise one another to a higher level of morality. They are authentic and transparent in their relationships, understand their own values and beliefs and are balanced in their judgments (decisions). They place the needs of others before their own and believe it is a privilege and responsibility to serve others. They are equipped with a sound foundation of ethical and caring behavior and attempt to enhance the personal growth of others to achieve their highest potential.*

LCA ETHICS » *Faith Statement*

**We Believe** the entire Bible to be the fully inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.

**We Believe** there is one God, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

**We Believe** in the deity of Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death, His resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of God, His personal return in power and glory.

**We Believe** in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.

LCA MORALITY » *Our Promise*

*To foster an open, collaborative learning environment that encourages students to recognize their potential, develop their character and expand their intellect. The foundation of Our Promise is anchored in a continuous journey of discovering the individual's unique God-given purpose and instilling the confidence to serve the broader community.  
This intentional approach is described as the 5-Ps of Legacy:*

**Praise:** Praise God in all we do; weaving Biblical principles into foundational instruction for every student.

**Provide:** Provide engaging learning opportunities that explore, inspire and create a thirst for knowledge for every student.

**Prepare:** Prepare the whole student (spiritually, emotionally, physically, intellectually and socially) to overcome the challenges of a rapidly changing world, with creativity and confidence.

**Pursue:** Pursue challenging, interactive learning opportunities that develop the natural curiosity of our students.

**Proceed:** Proceed into our communities, giving the student hands-on opportunities to serve and grow.



# OUR STUDENT MODEL » *DEFINED*



**SPIRITUALLY ALIVE:** A Legacy graduate will understand that life is about glorifying God by knowing and loving Him. Students will be challenged to hear God’s call, to live in relationship with Christ and to center one’s life on His Lordship. The interdenominational community will balance truth and grace with the understanding that students are in different places on their spiritual journey. Legacy will be a safe, non-judgmental environment where students can ask faith questions and struggle with spiritual truths in the process of making their faith in Christ real and alive.



**EMOTIONALLY AWARE:** A Legacy graduate will understand his/her uniqueness as a child of God. This understanding is a healthy and important first step in the lifelong journey of emotional awareness. A Christian understanding of what defines a fulfilling and joy-filled life highlights the insignificance of worldly success markers. A healthy, reflective knowledge of oneself leads to an acceptance of others and their differences and a positive ability to collaborate and learn in community.



**SOCIALLY ENGAGED:** A Legacy graduate will understand that as Christians we are called to live in community and to serve others. This understanding begins through modeling care and concern for all members of our Legacy community and emanates to the community at large. An education program rooted in Biblical principles of respect and responsibility develops a joy of service and a commitment to caring for all of God’s creation. We are Christ’s hands in this world.

# OUR STUDENT MODEL » *DEFINED*



**INTELLECTUALLY PREPARED:** A Legacy graduate will have a strong academic skill base to pursue their unique God-given purpose. An active learning approach found at all instructional levels will create learners who understand that knowledge is more than test scores and grades. An ownership of learning, a curiosity to understand and discover, an ability to ask good questions and search for answers, and the confidence and skills necessary to express oneself in writing, speaking and presentation media will open up a world of post-secondary opportunities for the graduate.



**PHYSICALLY ACTIVE:** A Legacy graduate will know that the body is the temple of God, a true gift to be understood and cared for. The goal is to equip students with the understanding of the importance and joy of physical fitness, competition, teamwork, healthy choices and proper nutrition combined with the discipline to align one's lifestyle with this understanding.

LCA HABITS » *ACT LCA*

***In living our mission and pursuing our vision at LCA, we believe that Christian relationships are foundational and that the principle of respect is essential to our core of excellence. "Act LCA" illuminates four groups of people to whom we are responsible and to whom our future success depends.***

***Colleagues:*** Colleague respect is the recognition that we are a community of believers and educators who care deeply for one another. As brothers and sisters in Christ, we are called to support each other in our work and in our life together. We recognize the unique skills and gifts of one another and we respectfully celebrate those differences. We will hold each other accountable to group expectations. We know that how we treat each other as adults is a model for our students.

***Students/Alumni:*** Student and Alumni respect is the recognition that all children, regardless of academic gifts and personality, are created by God. We must encourage all of our students to do their best whether in the classroom, the performing venue or the athletic field. We show respect by listening intently, holding students accountable to appropriate behavior, setting high standards, respecting opinions, advising and guiding appropriately and encouraging and uplifting all students that we are privileged to serve.

***Family:*** Family respect is the recognition that we exist because our families find value in the educational services we provide. We understand that building a school of excellence depends on the families and school working together, supporting and respecting each other's role in the lives of these children. We will listen to families, communicate clearly and timely about their children's progress, partner with them in affirming expectations and involve them in enriching our school community.

***Community:*** Community respect is the recognition that we serve God in the community, businesses and in the churches. We graciously open our doors to churches, businesses and community to form an interactive relationship that is mutually beneficial. We respect the role of the church in our students' lives and desire to partner with the church in the spiritual upbringing of our students. As an interdenominational school, we respect the doctrinal differences of the churches where our students attend and stress the unity we have in Christ.
