Mr. Stontz introduced this month's fruit of the Spirit theme of kindness by focusing on two Bible verses, Ephesians 4:32 and Colossians 3:12. His first point connected LCA's Homecoming week theme on Monday about dressing up as movie characters and challenged the students to be superheroes of kindness because God is the superman of kindness. Also, Mr. Stontz encouraged the students to put on their "capes of kindness" because God calls us to clothe ourselves with Himself.
