### Jesus in Matthew 11:29

Mark introduced this month's theme of gentleness by asking a pertinent question: Is gentleness for everyone? He began by sharing a story of his three-year-old son extending gentleness by holding the hand of his sobbing one-year-old sister as they were in the "Tot Tote" (bike stroller). She stopped crying as she experienced her brother's gentleness. Mark defined gentleness as being sensitive, kind, and driven by love. Also, he described how Jesus, the strongest man ever, was the most gentle man ever. Mark concluded by emphasizing that whether or not you are big or little, loud or quiet, Nydam or Domino, gentleness is for everyone!
