He furthered his questioning with, "How many of you have told your parents that you'd clean your room but then forget to do it? How many of you have told someone that you'd keep their secret but then didn't?" He mentioned that those are examples of being unfaithful. Darren explained that being faithful is doing what you say you are going to do and that the same is true with God. When God says He'll do something, He'll do it! Why will God do it? He is truthful. He cannot lie. He always tells the truth, so we can fully trust Him. He is powerful! Sometimes athletes brag "We're going to win this game." But then they end up losing the game. But God always wins! God doesn't change! He is faithful!

In conclusion, Darren reviewed these points about God's faithfulness: He is 1) truthful, 2) all-powerful, and 3) never changing. Therefore, God is faithful!
