
# MRS. SANDRA JOHNSON

Mrs. Johnson furthered the theme of God's faithfulness through the story of Joshua and Caleb spying out the Promised Land. She pointed out that God had told the Israelites that He would go ahead of them and help them enter this land; however, many of the spies were intimidated by the large cities and enormous giants present in the land. Yet Joshua and Caleb chose to trust in God's faithfulness and His promise to them rather than in the obstacles and challenges ahead of them. As a result, they were the only ones from their generation that were able to enter the Promised Land. Mrs. Johnson encouraged the students to believe in God's faithfulness, even if He calls us to do something that is challenging or difficult. She concluded with the inspirational verse from Isaiah 41:10 that emphasizes God's empowering strength that dispels our fear because of His presence in our lives.
