Firstly, Jeremy began chapel by giving students a practical way to exercise their patience: he told them he was going to give them a piece of chocolate and encouraged them to use patience in waiting for this piece of chocolate that they would receive in class later that day. Secondly, Jeremy gave an example of patience from Genesis regarding the time it took to fulfill God's promise to Abraham of having a son. After 15 years of waiting for the promise, God visited Abraham again and assured him that the promise would be fulfilled. Jeremy mentioned that it took another 10 years after that reassurance for Abraham and Sarah to give birth to Isaac totaling 25 years of patiently waiting! Lastly, Mr. Nydam encouraged the students to be faithfully patient because sometimes we have to wait a long time before we receive what has been promised to us.
