“You are blessed when you work for peace.”

—**Matthew 5:9 (NLT)**

Mr. Stontz concluded this month’s theme of peace by focusing on how students can find joy and blessing when we live out God’s call on our lives as peacemakers. He challenged students to be those who bring peace and not those who cause friction. Mr. Stontz also demonstrated some examples of friction and the unpleasantness it can cause, even having a volunteer create friction between a plastic knife and a balloon! He then encouraged students to not get heated up or explode (like a balloon) when they are in situations where there is friction because God has called them to be “peace officers.” Mr. Stontz ended his message by sharing a story from his days as a missionary kid in Romania. When he was 11 years old, he was wrongly accused of stealing and then beaten by a Romanian security guard, yet he experienced God’s peace and a miraculous and angelic deliverance after he “cast his cares upon the Lord” (1 Peter 5:7).
