"But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol." —**Galatians 5:22-23**

Firstly, Mrs. Gerber and Mr. Rudzitis led the students in three fun praise and worship songs: 1) God of Creation, 2) Jesus Loves Me, and 3) I Got the Joy. Then Mr. Nydam brilliantly and imaginatively compared the fruit of the Spirit to "tools in our toolbox" that help us through life and help us live like Jesus Christ. He explained that tools make our job and life easier, and he challenged the students with questions like this one, "How can you use joy as a tool to help others?" Mr. Nydam cleverly asked the students to imagine if we didn't have pencil sharpeners in school and our teacher asked us to use our teeth instead! He articulated how we need the right tools for the job; sometimes it will require love, sometimes patience, but we need to have all these tools of the fruits of the Spirit in our toolbox so that we can be shining lights in our world! Mr. Nydam concluded his message segueing into selfcontrol. He used an object lesson of using the right amount of control to hit an orange ball into a jar. He encouraged students to use the right amount of self-control, whether they need to try harder or settle down, here at school and at home.
