Porcia shared the story about Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane with His disciples. She explained how Jesus strongly encouraged His disciples to stay awake and pray with Him because it was the moment when Jesus needed their support and encouragement the most. Porcia explained Matthew 26:41 about how we can be very willing to do the right thing but are hindered by our sinful nature. She elucidated that when we are weak and when we want to do something wrong, we can call on Jesus, and we can call on our friends to help us use self-control. Even though we are weak and are tempted, we can overcome by His Word and His Spirit in us! In conclusion, Mr. Nydam shared his own story about falling asleep in a weird place and encouraged the students from John 13:34, "A new command I give you: love one another as I have loved you. And by this the world will know that you are my disciples."
