To begin chapel, Mrs. Gerber beautifully and prayerfully led the students in a worshipful rendition of "God Bless America" and the fun and action-filled "Fruits of the Spirit" song. Then Mrs. Johnson began her teaching with an object lesson. She had a folding chair set up and she began explaining how almost all chairs have four legs, and if you remove a leg, it becomes very difficult to sit on. She compared living for Christ to building and sitting in a strong chair. Mrs. Johnson illustrated how we need a firm foundation to stand (or sit) on. The first leg on the chair is faith: through faith in Christ, we are saved from our sins and are born again; and because of the Holy Spirit living within us, we have the power to be self-controlled. The second leg of the chair is hope: we depend on God and we trust that He'll do what He says He'll do. When we call on God, we have hope that He'll answer us. The third leg of the chair is love. Even if we accomplish incredible things, but do not have love, we have really accomplished nothing of eternal significance. The last leg that we have on the chair is charity and generosity. We need to be thankful for what God has done for us and we must show that love to others. We need to be thankful for the clothes we have, the house our parents have, and the food we eat; and we cannot be afraid of sharing what we have with others and those in need. She concluded by reviewing faith, hope, love, and charity with the students, encouraging them to pursue each of those virtues.
