Our precious Abigail and Isabelle were in a car accident on Thursday evening, April 6 when their car was hit by a truck on the way home from their softball game. Isabelle went home to be with Jesus, and after going to the hospital, Abigail was released on Friday with a concussion. We have been so overwhelmed by the love and support from friends, family, and the communities of Berean Christian Fellowship and Legacy Christian Academy. We are already

witnessing God's mighty hand at work as a result of your many prayers and look forward to sharing some of these in the future.

These times are hard and painful, yet they are not without hope. Paul encourages us to grieve as one with hope because Christ has defeated death. For Christians, death is not an ending but a new beginning. As a result, Paul says we can be sorrowful yet rejoicing because Christians die yet live on. In the midst of pain and grief, we have seen the Church being lived out, love being poured out, peace being experienced that only God can give, and felt confident that He who began a good work will carry it on to completion as He uses this tragedy for His glory.
