2017 Legacy Clay Target Team Spring Season

The Legacy Clay Target Team recently completed their spring trap shooting season. The team came in 4th place with four of our shooters ranked in the top 10 out of 150 participants in our conference - Jack Olson (was tied for 1st place but the tie breaker placed him in 2nd), Devin Delich (3rd), Donevan Walsh (7th), and Carson Sharp (9th). Also finishing in the top 25 out of 150 were Aaron Moots (12), and Cody Hanson (14), and in the female division Jessa Delich (13) and Cadence Werth (21) - a very respectable showing for our young team.

Shooters improved their scores over the course of the season through hours of practice and team coaching. All 21 Legacy team members will now compete in the Minnesota State High School Clay Target Championships to be held in Alexandria, MN on **June 13**. It is estimated that over 6,000 students from all over Minnesota will participate in the week-long trap shooting competition in classes depending on their school size. Our team of shooters will represent Legacy Christian Academy by demonstrating good sportsmanship, encouragement for each other, safety, and enjoyment of the sport - all for His Glory.
