The "flu" season is upon us. We are seeing an increase in influenza activity throughout the state of Minnesota and we are seeing cases at our school. At Legacy we want to do everything possible to keep your student safe and healthy. In order to prevent the further spread of the illness, we are asking all students and staff to stay home if they have influenza or influenza like illness (ILI). Influenza like illness is defined as a fever of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or greater and cough or sore throat (in the absence of a known disease other than influenza).

Here are some ways you can fight the flu:

- Stay home if you are ill. Stay home until fever is gone for more than 24 hours without fever reducing medications (ibuprofen/Advil or acetaminophen/Tylenol).
- Wash hands with soap and water thoroughly and often.
- Consider getting an influenza vaccine. It is not too late.
- Cover your cough and sneezes.
- Clean frequently touched items with a disinfectant.
- Drink lots of water, eat a balanced diet, and get plenty of rest.

In the Health Office we are tracking cases of influenza and ILI. Please let the Health Office know if your student gets influenza or has an ILI. This information is kept confidential.

We are also seeing an increase in stomach bugs causing vomiting and/or diarrhea. Please remember if your student has symptoms of a stomach bug, keep them home for at least 24 hours after their last episode of vomiting or diarrhea.


