

Andover, MN – On Wednesday, April 24, 2019, Legacy Christian Academy will be holding a Groundbreaking Ceremony at 1:00pm to celebrate the start of a new school expansion project.

Due to an increase in enrollment, a waiting list for additional student space and the loss of four portable classrooms, Legacy is expanding to increase enrollment in the school to an incredible 700 students each year. The new addition will include a technology/engineering lab, 2 science labs, business entrepreneurship center, athletic locker rooms, weight room, 2 art studios, band room, choir room, 3 music practice rooms, kiln room, flexible learning and social gathering spaces and is set to be completed by the Fall of 2020.

"Our community is excited about what God is doing at Legacy and has come together to pledge nearly \$6 million dollars to make this building a reality.
