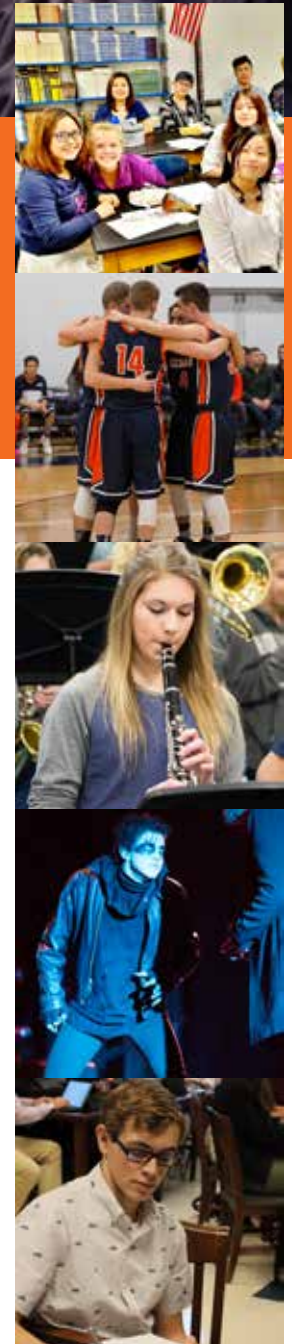

COLLEGE CREDITS AT LCA (AP & PSEO)

Legacy offers the opportunity for students to earn up to 37 college credits through our On-Site PSEO and Advanced Placement programs. In addition, students can take online PSEO classes in order to earn more college credit.

MODIFIED BLOCK SCHEDULE

Legacy follows a year-long, seven period modified block schedule. Students take 6-7 credits during each school year. Classes meet four days per week - three days for 45 minutes and one day for 90 minutes. The modified block promotes diverse teaching strategies such as sustained discussions, question and answer sessions, reflections, simulations, lab experiments, group projects, and cooperative learning.

UNIQUE OPPORTUNITIES

Legacy students have a number of unique educational and leadership development opportunities available to them throughout the school year.

WINTERIM: During a week in January, students participate in enrichment courses and trips.

CHICK-FIL-A LEADERSHIP ACADEMY: This is a monthly gathering of students through training put together by Chick-fil-A. The program allows students to serve the community and learn through active participation in projects that will allow them to practice what they are learning. LCA is one of only three high schools in Minnesota currently involved in the program.

BUSINESS PROJECT MANAGEMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP: This elective course places students in real world business environments where they not only study innovation, entrepreneurship, and business, but also hone their soft skills and workplace professionalism. This class enables students to excel in the collaborative and team-based work environment they will experience in their careers.

EXTRACURRICULAR ENROLLMENT

Legacy offers 22 varsity sports. 69% of our high school students participate on an athletic team. Students also have the opportunity to participate in the arts. Legacy offers music (instrumental and choral opportunities including a student-led worship team), visual arts (painting, drawing, 2D, 3D, graphic design, and video production), and drama (one-act performances, fall drama, and spring musical productions). Students also participate in clubs and activities offered through the school.
