March 12, 2020 - Pre-Spring Break Planning Notice

Dear Legacy Community,

As the concern regarding the spread of the coronavirus increases worldwide and in our communities, Legacy Christian Academy has taken and is continuing to take steps to reduce the spread of illness and protect the safety of students, staff, and visitors in our building.

Our administration and faculty have discussed how student learning can continue, in the rare event that our school be closed temporarily. We have already developed strategies for providing age-appropriate, remote lessons to students, taking accessibility into consideration. We will communicate more details around what this will look like if it becomes necessary.

At this time there are no immediate plans to move in a remote learning direction; however, with so much changing so quickly, it could become a reality in the future. As a precautionary and preparatory measure, we are sending students home today with books and other resources necessary to continue studies from home in case the need arises following Spring Break. We will continue to actively monitor the situation and communicate accordingly if adjustments to the day-to-day operations become necessary.

We are in contact with district officials and the Minnesota Department of Health to stay updated on the situation. We are also partnering with the Minnesota Department of Education and Anoka-Hennepin School District who are working with county and state resources if infectious disease mitigation plans are necessary, which they shared is not a current concern.

Legacy will follow the expert guidance from the U.S. Center for Disease Control, Minnesota Department of Health and county public health. MDH continues to stress common sense illness prevention strategies such as staying home when sick, covering your coughs and sneezes, and frequent hand washing. We echo the recommendation and ask that students with any signs of respiratory illness or flu-like symptoms be kept home after Spring Break.

In the event that the coronavirus becomes an issue that impacts the school day, Legacy will use the communication systems in place to widely share information with our community.

May you remember that God is in control and that the fear of the unknown does not need to rule us.
