



3's for Schultz

The Lions boys basketball team broke the school record with 251 made 3 point shots last season. The focus on shooting 3's was more than just moving towards traditional basketball; players were shooting to raise money for their form teacher and Soccer Coach, Jon Schultz.

Jon Scultz was diagnosed with Adrenal Cortical Cancer on April 7, 2018. The disease is extremely rare, especially for someone as young as Coach Schult. The invasive

surgery and extensive chemotherapy forced Jon to resign from his positions at Legacy, but not before he left his own legacy on these young men.

"Coach Schultz is a reminder to me of the man I want to be someday. A man that is willing to step out in his faith and show that while doing what he loves," says Senior Captain, Primeau Hill.

"How can we help?" is a question the boys asked. The solution; raising \$1 for every 3 the team made during the season. The response; over 30 families pledging their support of Coach Schultz!

"The response from our

community does not surpise me at all," says Head Coach, Nathan Bellefeuille. "Legacy is extremely supportive as a community that cares for every student, teacher, administrator and coach. Times like this are when our families shine the brightest."
