UNIQUE OPPORTUNITIES

Legacy students have a number of unique educational and leadership development opportunities available to them throughout the school year.

WINTERIM: During a week in January, students participate in enrichment courses and trips.

BIG BUDDY PROGRAM: The Big Buddy Program gives students an opportunity to mentor and build relationships between 6th-12th students and PreK-5th grade students.

AFFINITY GROUPS: Once a week, students meet with their Affinity Groups, which are designed to help direct students to lead Legacy in a particular area through serving, awareness, education and school-wide experiences.

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS: Optional Bible study groups meet once a week.

PARLIAMENT: During the required Biblical Worldview course, students participate in a cumulative evaluation of analytical skills and the ability to speak knowledgeably in the voice of both a biblical Christian worldview and an assumed non-Christian worldview.

CAPSTONE PROJECT: During the required Christian Theology course, students propose, design, strategize, implement, and lead an original project/mission/outreach/event that is an expression of you that impacts others.
