Overview:

In the role of Grounds Technician, you will support the Facilities & Athletic Departments in maintaining all exterior landscapes. You can expect to perform various field maintenance duties that include operating mowers and trimmers to maintain fields and edge sidewalks; spread dirt, sand, gravel, seed or other grounds materials; assist with the **initial** laying out of sports fields according to specific dimensions; provide tree and shrub care; blow leaves/debris from walkways or grounds; pick up and dispose of debris/litter from ground areas; empty trash containers; monitor irrigation systems; pest control. You may also be called on to assist with setup/breakdown for special events and activities; lift/move equipment, outdoor furniture, and heavy materials; load, transport, and unload event materials. Required schedule is flexible, but ability to work evenings and weekends as needed is required.

Job Requirements & Qualifications:

- Possess a strong Christian faith with a solid knowledge of the Bible, a growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Must possess strong attention to detail while seeing the big picture
- Focused with the ability to anticipate the next task
- Ability to work independently as well as take direction
- Routinely inspect for unusual conditions or needed maintenance
- Basic level of comfort using technology for managing maintenance work orders and schedules
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 75lbs and work outdoors in all conditions
- Exhibits exceptional communication skills with colleagues, students, parents and visitors
- Demonstrated character of integrity, taking pride in your work, ensuring the exterior appearance of campus is first-class
- Education/Experience: High school diploma or GED is required. Previous experience and/or training in landscape maintenance OR any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience
