Overview:

Job Requirements & Qualifications:

- Possess a strong Christian faith with a solid knowledge of the Bible, a growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ, and a demonstrated character of integrity. Believe and actively support the school's Statement of Faith.
- Possess a passion for Christian education and student discipleship. Individual must be comfortable connecting the biblical truths and biblical worldview perspectives to their students' lives.
- Organize and lead a variety of activities appropriate for school-age children. Activities may include arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, etc.
- Assist in maintaining accurate program records including incident reports, daily rosters, logbook documentation, and attendance records (*when needed).
- Ability to manage student behavior while building positive relationships among K-4 students.
- Good skills in communication, organization, and human relations.
- Ability to recognize and react calmly and effectively in all situations.
- Ability to work with all functions - administration, support staff, other faculty, and students.
- Previous experience working with K-4 aged children is preferred but not required.
- Perform all physical aspects of the position, including moving around, bending, reaching, and lifting up to 50 pounds at a time.
- Must be currently enrolled at Legacy as a high school student 15 or older.
