NEW WEBFORM FOR REPORTING AN ABSENCE: We have added an option for parents to report an absence by completing the Attendance Webform in the FACTS Family Portal or clicking Attendance in the Legacy App. Utilizing this form will ensure you submit all the necessary information to properly record your student's absence, late arrival, or early dismissal.



SAFETY AND SECURITY NOTES: Legacy has adopted the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) used for crisis communication throughout Anoka County. The SRP provides a consistent and common language for emergency situations in schools and communities with five actions—HOLD, SECURE, LOCKDOWN, EVACUATE, and SHELTER—to provide clear directives for staff, students, and first responders during various emergencies. This standardized approach enhances safety by promoting predictability and efficient communication in critical incidents.
